Systems may include mental health, juvenile justice, children services, substance abuse, school IEP, or developmental disability.</p>	<p>Referrals can be initiated by any agency (including juvenile court) or any family voluntarily seeking services. All referrals will be directed to the Meigs County FCFC Coordinator.</p>	<p>A parent can self refer a child by contacting Brooke Pauley, FCFC Coordinator at (740) 992-2117 ext. 104 . A meeting date will be scheduled with the coordinator to complete referral information, as well as a release of information. The family may also contact any agency with whom they are currently involved.</p>	<p>The family is offered a Parent Peer Supporter, or Parent Advocate, upon enrollment in service coordination. This support may be accessed at any time while a child is enrolled in service coordination.</p>	<p>A family who disagrees with a service coordination decision may file a dispute resolution form. Upon receipt, the Council Coordinator will notify the Chair of the Council and the Administrative Agent of the complaint.
