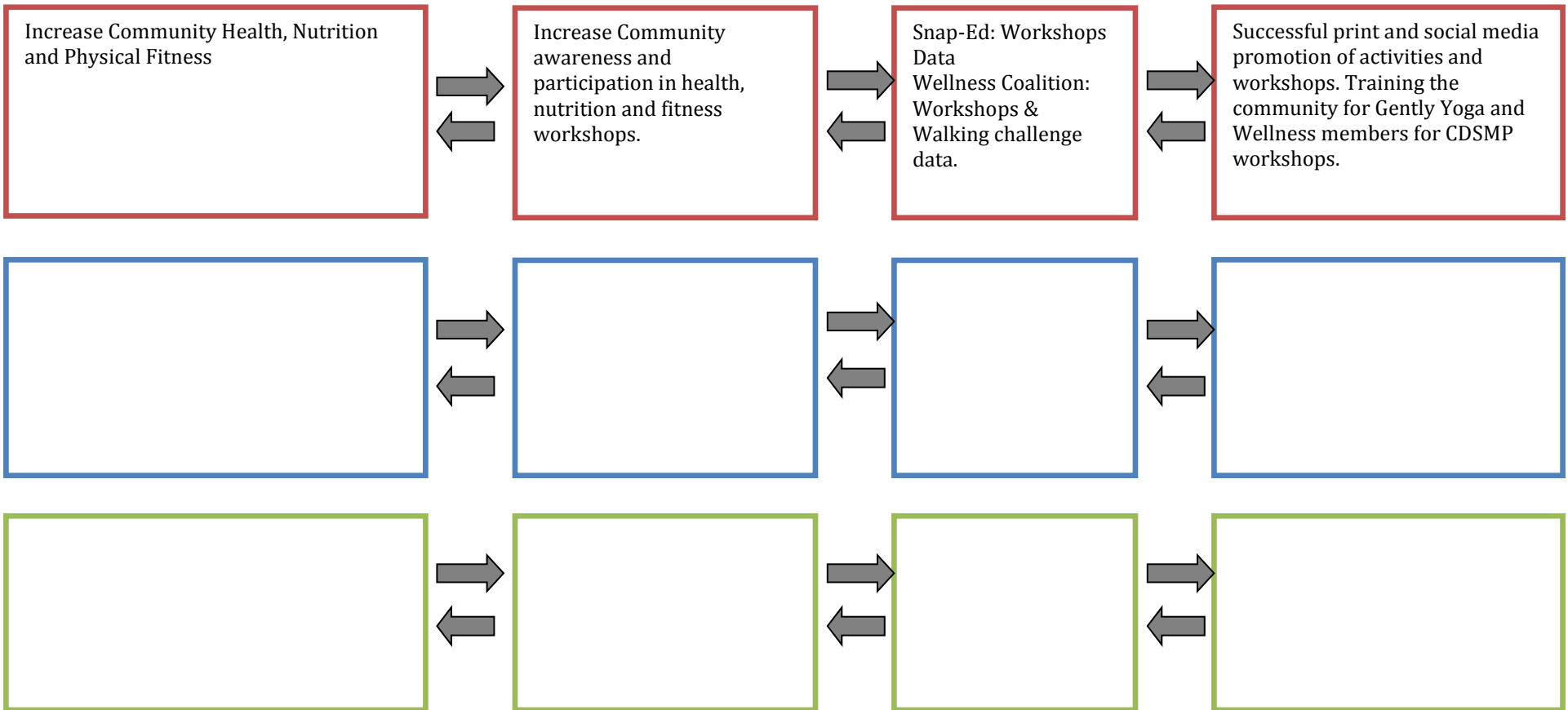

It is sometimes difficult for members to find time for data collection as many agency members have limited work time and many different duties.

The Council along with members of the Wellness Coalition, local health agencies and community members have worked together to make The 100 Miles in 100 Days a great success. We had over 200 residents sign up for the challenge and 130 complete. Of those that completed, 30% reported improvement in one of the following: weight loss, lowered blood pressure, better management of diabetes. 7 community Members were trained in the CDSMP. One workshop was completed with 4 enrolled and one completing the program.
