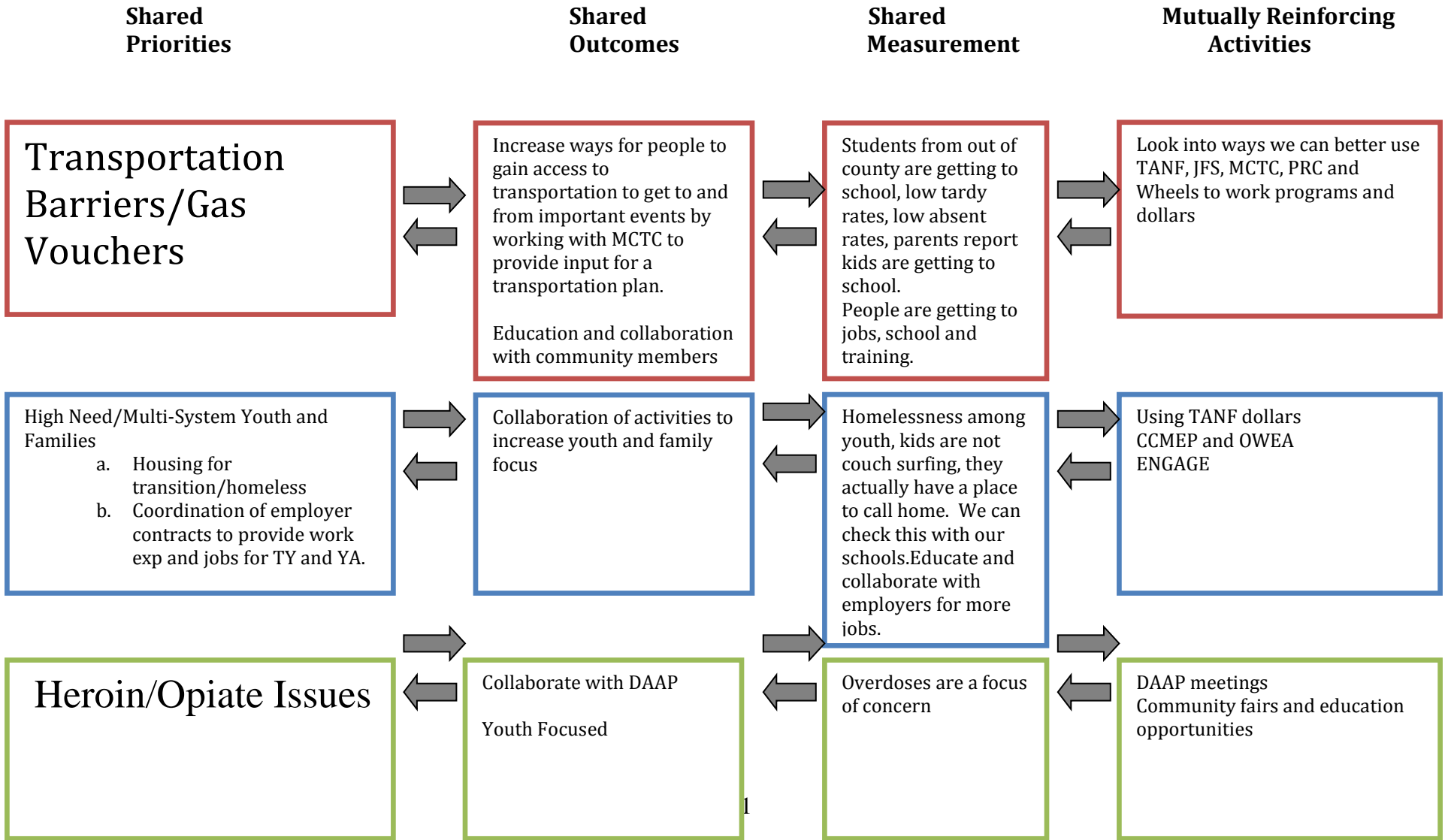


# Morrow County Family and Children First Council Shared Plan Update for SFYs 17-19

**Morrow was asked to expand our explanation on several areas. Our priorities remain the same, however we did provide a bit more to each area in how we will measure and the outcomes.**

Data collection for Morrow County is always difficult since FCFC is small and the county is rather poor on resources.
2. Identify any successes/how implementing this plan has worked to strengthen the council and county collaboration.
  - FCFC has formed a solid relationship with DAAP (Drug and Alcohol Awareness Prevention of Morrow County) to form a youth sector, combat Opiate Issues, and has worked with the Ohio Attorney General office to help educate community members on drug trends across the state.
  - We have also worked closely with JFS and our county transportation division to work out plans to cover all county transit needs including out of county youth coming into Morrow County for education. This is a work in progress. This is also a priority on the CHIP and FCFC council coordinator is the lead on an initiative under this plan. Safe Routes to School.
  - We have partnered with several local businesses to begin providing alternative working opportunities for our DD population and youth. Several have hired some staff and several have developed jobs for these individuals.
  - More work is happening toward transition youth including housing in our county for this population.
  - Also working on bringing more training on TIC to Morrow County.
