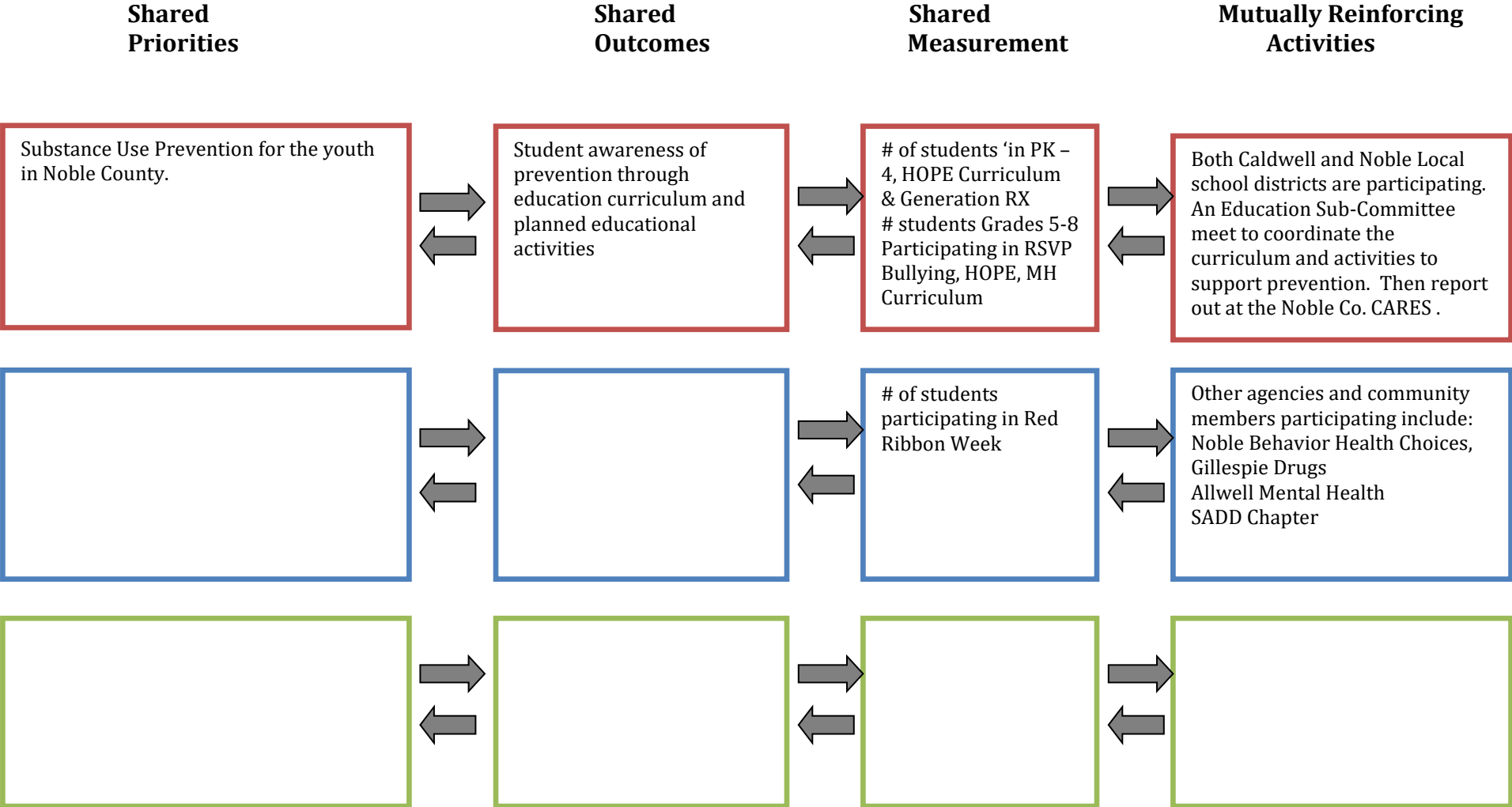

Noble County CARES began a coalition on December 8, 2016 during our NC FCFC monthly meeting. An Education Sub-Committee was appointed, consisting of both school districts representatives and Noble County OSU Extension. This sub-committee hold monthly meetings to discuss curriculum and activities.

The committee has helped to bring in more community partners. For example, a local pharmacist helps with the HOPE program presenting for Generation RX. With both school districts working together it has helped the community realize that children are learning about all substance use, bulling and mental health.
