


Data collection is still not as strong as the Council needs to support effective decision-making. Technical assistance in data collection was included in the Strong Families, Safe Communities grant which was funded. These funds will help the community track and analyze data more effectively.

2. Identify any successes/how implementing this plan has worked to strengthen the council and county collaboration.

The community has reinvigorated high-fidelity wraparound and has trained 6 facilitators. The Strong Families, Safe Communities grant has a full-time wraparound coordinator position which will help us be more effective. PAX is now in 125 classrooms!
